1. Getting Started

Pinnacle will use PlayMetrics as the primary platform for registration, team placement, calendars, practice and tournament details, parent/player group chats, and club payments. Once your athlete is placed, please make sure all participating parents or guardians have access and keep notifications enabled.

- Complete all requested registration and payment information in PlayMetrics.
- Review your team calendar regularly and communicate conflicts as early as possible.
- Use the team communication channel for routine questions and updates.
- Keep contact information current so you do not miss schedule, travel, or tournament announcements.

2. Club Leadership and Support

3. Boys Team Experience Options

Athletes will be offered a team based on their tryout evaluation. Families may choose a lower-commitment option—Traditional instead of Elite, or Club Lite instead of Elite/Traditional—subject to roster availability.

- This season we will be implementing a new stats system. Every head coach will have an iPad and an Istatvb3 subscription to ensure all of our decisions are made with the most information.
- This season we will be using AIM+ for film and highlights.
